### ARCHITECTURAL COPPER AWARDS SHORTLIST ANNOUNCED

**Eight very different entries have been shortlisted by a panel of architect judges for the 2017 European Copper in Architecture Awards. Members of the public can now vote for their favourite shortlisted project via [copperconcept.org](http://copperconcept.org) until 31<sup>st</sup> August.**

The eighteenth iteration of the biennial European Copper in Architecture Awards celebrates the beauty and versatility of copper and its alloys through the finest contemporary architecture. The 2017 judging panel consisted of four architects, all recipients of previous Copper in Architecture Awards: Ebbe Waehrens (BBP ARKITEKTER, Copenhagen), Maxime Enrico, (LAN, Paris), Ville Hara (Avanto Architects, Helsinki) and Craig Casci (GRID Architects, London).

The judges were impressed by the quality of entries generally and the range of copper applications displayed. Choosing from the 35 entries – ranging from major public buildings to modest interior interventions – presented a real challenge but the judges eventually settled on eight projects that stood out from the rest, revealing a diversity of typologies and design approaches, and exceptional architecture.




